



#### 1. Set the Tone and Intention

- Begin with Bismillah.
- Remind students that knowledge is from Allah and for the purpose of knowing Allah better.

#### 2. Preview the Issue

• Cover: Ask your students: What do you think the issue is about? What do you know about the various topics listed at the top? Describe the cover of the magazine.


#### 4. Ninety-Nine (Pg 6)

#### **Comprehension questions:**

• "What does Al-Wajid mean?"(The Finder)

#### **Activities:**

- Create or buy pocket notebooks!
  - Use each page for a different Prophet or notable figure in Islamic history, and each time students learn something new encourage them to note it down in their notebook under the respective person!
- Memorize Surah Duha and its translation.
   <u>Discuss Ayah 6</u> of Prophet Muhammad
   (PBUH) being an orphan and Allah being Al-Wajid and giving Prophet Muhammad
   (PBUH) shelter.



#### 5. The Prophet's Kindness (Pg 8)

#### **Comprehension questions:**

- "How do you react when things around you change and shift?" (Open Answer)
- "Can you think of a time you felt sad or missed someone? How did you express your feelings?" (Open Answer)

#### **Activity:**

• <u>Plant a tree</u> in your school gardens and give it a lot of love and care.

- Write stories individually or as a class that include the words "magic carpet"
  - Use the Funlasia drawings as inspirations!

#### 7. World Folk Tales (Pg 12)

#### **Pre-reading questions:**

 "What do you think it means to have a clean heart?" (Open Answer)

#### **Comprehension questions:**

- "What words do you not recognize from the passage? What do you think they mean?" (Open Answer)
- "If you were asked to paint a mural for Sultan Batu, what would you draw?" (Open Answer)

#### **Comprehension Questions:**

- "Who originally built the Kaaba alongside the Prophet Ibrahim (PBUH)?" (Prophet Isma'il)
- "The Zabur, or Psalms, was revealed to which Prophet?" (Prophet Dawud)

#### **Comprehension Questions:**

- "\_\_\_\_help you understand and share smiles." (*Mirror Neurons*)


#### **Activity:**

#### Activity:

- <u>Draw</u> the tree Adam (AS) and Eve ate from.
   Give students sticky notes or small pieces of paper, allowing them to think and write down different sins and mistakes kids struggle with.
  - Paste the sticky notes around the tree.
  - Discuss each mistake: why your students think kids make those sins and how kids can stay away from them.

  - Allow students an opportunity for extra credit if they follow the tutorials!

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
