Atlasia Toolbox



1. Set the Tone and Intention

- Begin with Bismillah.
- Remind students that knowledge is from Allah and for the purpose of knowing Allah better.

2. Preview the Issue:

- *Cover:* Ask your students: What do you think the issue is about? What do you know about the various topics listed at the top? Describe the cover of the magazine.




3. Weekly Calendar

- Write down the days of the week on the classroom board! Each day has a fun activity you can incorporate to stimulate students.

4. Ninety-Nine (Pg 6)

- Comprehension Questions:
 - What does Al-Haqq (The Truth) mean?
 - When you are faced with the truth on the Day of Judgment, how do you think it will feel? (*Open Answer*)
- Activities:
 - Draw a picture of what truth means to you and how it helps you make choices.
 - Share a time when the truth brought you peace or clarity. Discuss why honesty and belief in Allah's truth are important.



5. The Prophet's Kindness (Pg 8)

- **Reflection:** Discuss Prophet Muhammad's connection to the Kaaba and what it means to Muslims.
- **Art:** Draw the Kaaba and add symbols of peace, faith, and love.
- **Poetry:** Write a short poem about the Kaaba and its whispers of faith and inspiration.




6. Funlasia (Pg 10)

- Ask students, "If you could step through your door, where would it take you?"
- Give them time to imagine and encourage all ideas. Let them describe what they see, hear, and feel beyond the door.
- Remind them that there's no right or wrong answer—just their unique imagination.



8. Diary of Layla (Pg 22)

- **Design Kites:** Have students create and decorate their own kite designs.
- **Try Marbling Art:** Explore the Ebru art method by using paper and ink to create patterns.
- **Kindness Projects:** Encourage small acts of kindness like painting stones or baking for others.
- **Trust Reflection:** Ask students to reflect on a moment when they had to trust someone or something.



9. Zoom: The World of Music (Pg 31)

- Pre-reading Question:
 - “Have you ever played an instrument or made music? How did it feel?” (Open answer)
- Activities:
 - **DIY Instruments:** Make simple instruments with household items like rubber bands or boxes.
 - **Music Reflection:** Discuss how different music makes you feel—happy, calm, or energized.
 - **Explore World Music:** Listen to music from other cultures and talk about the unique sounds.
 - **Islamic Reflection:** How can we use music or sounds to express gratitude and appreciation for Allah's creations?



10. Stories of the Prophets (Pg 36)

- Question:
 - What did Prophet Hud warn his people about? (A great storm if they didn't change their ways.)
- Activities:
 - **Read and Reflect:** Read Prophet Hud's story with your family and discuss how true strength comes from kindness, humility, and faith.
 - **Art Activity:** Draw the storm and buildings from Prophet Hud's story.
 - **Memorization:** Memorize part of Surah Hud and reflect on its message of faith.



11. Tech High 5 (Pg 38)

- Question:
 - How do self-driving cars navigate the road? (They use cameras and sensors to see the road and make decisions.)
- Activities:
 - **Research Hyperloop:** Watch a video on how the Hyperloop works and compare it to regular trains.
 - **Design Your Own Future Transport:** Have students imagine and draw their own futuristic vehicle. Encourage creativity with features like flying or running on renewable energy!



12. Donkey Dan Interviews (Pg 40)

- Comprehension Question:
 - What inspired Nasr to start Juice Dudez? (The lack of fresh and healthy juices made from real ingredients, inspired by growing up on a fruit farm.)
- Activities:
 - **Sketch Your Dream Smoothie:**
Imagine you're creating your dream smoothie! Sketch it out and label the ingredients you would add.
 - **Community Impact Discussion:**
Discuss how you or your family could give back to your community, just like Juice Dudez does. Think of fun ways to make others smile or help those around you!
